How to administer eye drop medication?



Wipe off any excess medication on the bottle with a clean gauze or tissue.



- Pull down your lower eyelid and ensure the dropper tip does not touch eye or eyelashes. Squeeze the bottle gently and let the eye drop falls into the eye pocket.
- Close the eyes for a while after instillation. Do not blink.



Wipe off any excess liquid around your eyes with a clean gauze or tissue.

Do's and Don'ts when applying eye drops



Do not share eye drops with other people or apply expired eye drops.



Before applying, wash your hands thoroughly with soap and running water.



Follow the instructions (dosage and administration) strictly.




If you need to apply two or more types of eye drops, wait for 5 minutes before applying the next eye drops.



For eye suspension, shake the bottle well before applying.



How to use eye drop medication in a dimple bottle?






Remove the outer wrap from the cap.

Method 1: Pull the plastic flap and remove it from the cap.

Method 2: Hold the cap firmly and twist counterclockwise to remove the outer wrap.




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Hold the bottle upright and shake well.



How to use eye drop medication in a dimple bottle?



Remove the cap from the bottle. Hold the bottle at the dimpled part. Pull down your lower eyelid and ensure dropper tip does not touch eye or eyelashes. Squeeze the bottle gently and let the eye drop falls into the eye pocket. Close the eyes for a while after instillation. Do

Do's and Don'ts when applying eye drops


- 1. You may find it difficult to apply the eye drops if other parts of the bottle is held. Ensure you're holding the dimpled part of the bottle.
- 2. Do not press the bottle too hard as this will lead to excess output of eye drops.
- **3.** Hold the bottle vertically to the eye when applying the eye drops.

How to use single-use (disposable) eye drop medication?

- 1. Remove single-use container from the strip.
- Open the single-use container by twisting off the tab (the part where no solution is contained) as shown in the figure below.
- 3. Discard 1 or 2 drops before applying on the eye.
- 4. Ensure the tip of the container do not touch the eye while applying the eye drops



Note:

- 1 Pressure exerted on the strip may cause the cap to open. Be careful when you are carrying it around.
- **2** After applying, dispose the single-use container. Any remaining solution in the container cannot be stored and used again.
